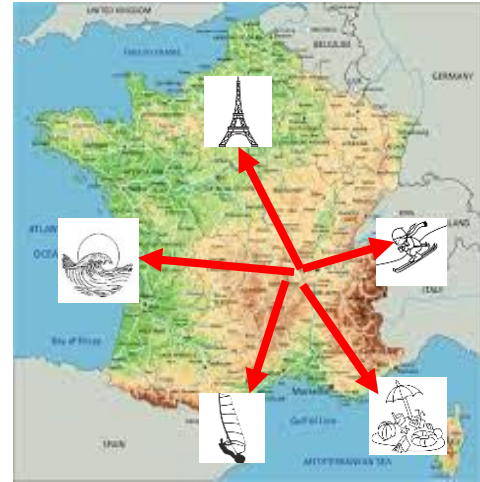


Positions of fellowship/resident in Lyon (France): 1 or 2 years

The Department of anaesthesia HFME (Mother and Child Hospital) is located at Lyon, the second largest city in France, ideally located in the middle of the country, in the Auvergne Rhône Alpes region. It is also the capital of the French gastronomy!



The Department of anaesthesia HFME fellowships offer a rich clinical exposure to high complexity cases in two domains: paediatric and obstetric anaesthesia.

1. Fellows in the HFME **Obstetric Anaesthesia Division** participate in the care of high-risk parturients. Patients from the Auvergne Rhône Alpes region with maternal or foetal-cardiac, neurological or haematological disorders are preferentially referred to our hospital centre for peri-partum care. Fellows are actively involved in the clinical decisions by taking part in multidisciplinary meetings that include maternal foetal medicine, obstetricians and other consultants as needed, such as pulmonary, cardiology, surgical specialists. Fellows actively participate in managing the labour ward anaesthesia team, which includes residents and nurse anaesthetists. Fellows also provide anaesthesia for patients undergoing gynaecologic and urologic procedures. During the fellowship year, there is an opportunity to learn other anaesthesia skills, such as point of care ultrasound, and to participate in research projects.

Number of deliveries: 5000/yr Gynecologic surgery: 2500/yr

2. The HFME **Paediatric anaesthesia division** provides a training opportunity to acquire knowledge and skills in **Paediatric Anaesthesia**. Goals of this fellowship are the acquisition of the specialized fund of knowledge, clinical judgment and technical skills that are required to independently provide safe, evidence-based anaesthetic care for a wide variety of paediatric patients. Fellows are involved in the care of children of all ages (including premature neonates) with or without associated medical comorbidities, undergoing surgical or diagnostic procedures, either simple or complex, such as neurosurgery, renal or liver transplantation.
