Program

We are confident that we are offering you a very interesting program on state-of-the-art pediatric anesthesia with topics including updates on patient safety, ultrasound in pediatric anesthesia, insights into neonatology, periprocedural care, and current controversies (environmental impact, artificial intelligence, and education). Furthermore, we will have the classical editor picks (presented by Editors Daniele de Luca, Suellen Walker, and Laszlo Vutskits), 'My Worst Nightmare', 'Best abstracts' session, and poster rounds (with traditional paper posters).

Abstracts

We are proud that almost 100 abstracts have been accepted for presentation as paper posters. We believe, that old-fashioned paper posters stimulate the discussion between the presenter and the audience in the most optimal way. Furthermore, the best eight abstracts will be selected by the scientific team for oral presentation in the main lecture hall on Friday afternoon in the "best abstract competition".

Workshops and problem-based learning sessions

We are particularly happy to welcome our colleagues from the Dept. of Anesthesiology, Perioperative Medicine and Intensive Care, J. E. Purkynje University, Masaryk Hospital, Ústí nad Labem- KAPIM, who have organized point-of-care Ultrasound workshops for congress attendees under the lead of prof. Vladimír Černý, head of KAPIM and Czech Society of Anesthesiology and Intensive Care Medicine and associate professor Roman Skulec. Together with their team, they will introduce workshop participants to focused ultrasound of the chest, and abdomen and give advice on ultrasound-guided cannulation.

Furthermore, Dr. Robert Flint (Clinical pharmacologists Erasmus MC, Rotterdam, the Netherlands) will provide 2 interactive workshops on *clinical pharmacology* in children using computer models.

Next, because of the success of last year, we also provide problem-based learning sessions to stimulate interaction and sharing of knowledge among participants of the conference. This is a format in which a maximum of 8 participants will initiate the discussion of clinical approaches to cases presented by the lead moderator. We have a large variety of topics:

- IV access, what line for what patient?
- Mediastinal masses-challenges
- Bronchoscopy
- The art of extubation
- Spinal Cord Injury

Invitation to participate in Cricket study

The APRICOT and NECTARINE study showed us that anaesthesia in children can be associated with severe adverse events and might contribute to morbidity and mortality. However, less is known about differences regarding practice and the associated outcomes worldwide. So, we would like to conduct a new worldwide multi-center observational study for children up to 16 years undergoing tracheal intubation.

At the moment, we are in the recruiting phase of the centers. We are aiming to enroll 100,000 patients in 500 centers worldwide. We seek national coordinators handling the ethical approval in their country.

The primary investigator of interested centers needs to register the center at https://redcap.link/CRICKETstudy. For further questions, you can contact cricket@insel.ch

Once enough centers are willing to participate and have the approval of their responsible ethics committee, we plan to start the trial on 01 January 2024.
